## PE SPORTS FUNDING STATEMENT

### What is the sports funding grant?

This a grant that schools receives to improve provision of physical education (PE) and sport in primary schools.

For the 2015-2016 academic year we were allocated **£9,735. The school's total spend is:£11,030**

### Sports and Year Groups Targeted (2015-2016)

- Each class will receive at least 1 hour coaching every half term (Reception- Year 6)
- Rugby World Cup festival- Autumn term (Whole school)
- Gymnastics training for staff and sessions for each class (Whole school and all staff)
- Olympic festival- Summer term (Whole school)
- Islington competitions: Handball, Tag Rugby, Basketball, Football, Hockey, Netball, Athletics, Rounders, Tennis and Cross Country (Years 3-6)
- Swimming:
  - Pupils who are in Years 3 & 4 – increasing the percentage of pupils achieving the national expectations of swimming 25 metres
- Football
  - Year 5 & 6 Establishment of new interschool league in the summer term for the seven Catholic schools in Islington
- Gifted and talented competition- children excelling in sport participate in an Islington run competition.
