

Cake SALE

The cake sale has always been a highlight for lots of children (and parents) once a month on a Friday. It has also been a great fundraiser for the PA, who's great work benefits all the children at our school. So, we are pleased to announce that the cake sale will be returning but with some changes to allow for social distancing.

The sale will take place on Friday 20th November & Friday 11th December during school time. Each year group bubble will be given a time to go to the cake shop to buy a cake which they will then bring back to class to eat with their friends.

We think this will be a lovely treat for the children and the funds raised will help the PA continue their excellent support for the school.

On the allotted Fridays, Parents & children can bring donations of cakes into school and leave them on the table in the playground first thing in the morning.

The children will also be asked to bring £1 in with them with which to buy their cake. If you do not feel able to contribute cakes or any money then please do not worry. All children will be allowed to take part and will receive a cake.

Each year group will also select Young Enterprise "Shop Keepers" who will help run the shops. This will give the children real world experiences using their maths skills. In a time whereby children (and adults) have limited opportunities to handle coins, this will give them a real world experience.

We ask that parents remember the following:



All cakes should be individual and be shop bought (due to corona virus we cannot sell any homemade cakes, no matter how delicious).
