Curriculum & Achievement Committee Aims and Responsibilities

Strategic Aims

 To help ensure that St Joan of Arc Catholic Primary School delivers a curriculum which meets the requirements of the National Curriculum and the Diocese of Westminster and offers all our pupils the opportunity to achieve their full academic, creative and sporting potential in a stimulating, and challenging teaching and learning environment

Responsibilities

- To ensure that the school curriculum is broad and balanced and relevant to the needs of all pupils.
- To ensure that the National Curriculum and Religious Education is delivered in accordance with the legal framework and other applicable requirements.
- To provide, with the assistance of the Headteacher and staff, information for the Governing Body about how the curriculum is taught, evaluated and resourced.
- To report back, as requested, with the assistance of the Headteacher and staff, to the full Governing Body on any aspect of the curriculum.
- To contribute as appropriate to, and monitor and assess progress made on implementing, the School Improvement Plan/Subject Managers' Action Plans and any post inspection action plan.
- To coordinate the role of curriculum link governors where considered appropriate.
- To monitor and review all curriculum-related policies in line with such policy review timetable as the Governing Body may decide or [Local Education Authority] require.
- To monitor the effectiveness and implications of pupil targets and assessment procedures throughout the school.
- To monitor, keep under review and report on student progress and achievement particularly in relation to agreed pupil performance targets.
- To ensure that the requirements of pupils with SEND are met.
- To ensure parents are kept informed about key developments relating to the curriculum and provided with the necessary information on their children's progress in line with legal requirements.
- To ensure school INSET days are linked to the school improvement plan priorities.
- To review the policy on, and provision of, collective worship and for RE.
- To review the policy and provision for Relationships, Sex and Health Education(RSHE)
- To approve and selectively monitor off -site visits and activities of more than 24 hours involving a potential hazard.
