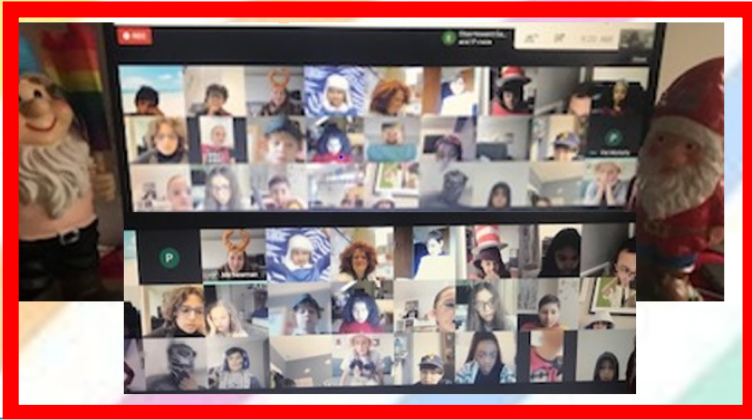

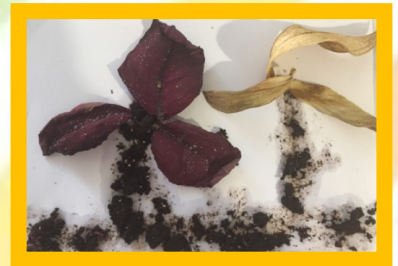

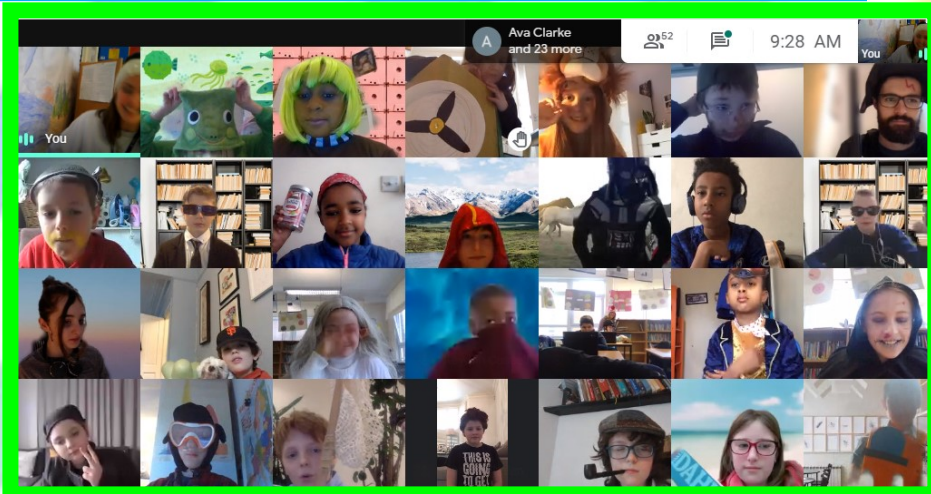
Show and Tell!
