Auction:







Parent Forum Summary:

On Friday 13th May, the School Governors will be hosting the first Parents' Forum of the school year. These meetings are an opportunity for parent representatives from each class to bring their ideas and feedback directly to the Governing Body and a representative of the School's Senior Leadership Team. They are different to the Parents' Association meetings as they are to designed to inform the School's Governing Body about what is working well and what could be improved from a parents' perspective. Meetings are documented and shared at the full Governing Body meetings.

Parent representatives for each class will be asked to share the points of discussion in advance so they can represent your views. We ask that all input is related to whole class/year issues rather than individual concerns, which should always be raised directly with the class teacher in the first instance. These meetings have been really useful in the past in helping to share information and understanding of how the school works and in helping to see how we can improve the school for pupils and parents going forward.

Mental Health Awareness Week:

Nationally, next week is Mental Health Awareness Week. To mark this event and continue to cover statutory government guidance, our school will have a focus day on Friday 13th May. The children will have a number of class sessions on mindfulness, building positive connections, support networks, promoting positive mental health and strategies on how to deal with emotions. As a way to celebrate all our differences, we are asking children to 'dress to express' on Friday 13th by wearing odd socks for the day- the funkier the better! All children will be required to wear full school uniform (or PE kit if it is your child's allocated PE day) except the odd socks.
