

English

- We will be reading the non-fiction book Winter Sleep: A Hibernation Story- Sean Taylor Cinyee Chiu to write own narrative.
- We will also be introducing Orion and the Dark by Emma Yarlett a contemporary fiction book and using this to write in role, free verse poetry and book making.

RE

- Judaism -We will be exploring the Jewish faith and looking at Shabbat; we will also think about the celebrations and rituals of this sacred day.
- Advent/ Christmas. Children will recognise that Advent is a time of preparation and describe things we see during this time.

RSE

- We will be revisiting and consolidating Year 1 learning of Me, My Body and My Health. Understanding we are unique with individual gifts, talents and skills.
- We will be naming our body parts and understanding how we take care of our body.

Physical Education

- We will be learning ball games including tennis, rugby and cricket.
- Children will be looking at dancing with feeling and coordination.
- In gymnastics we will be covering travelling: close to the ground, with different body parts high.

Maths

Measurement: Money

- Children will be learning to recognise and use symbols for pounds (£) and pence (p)
- Combine amounts to make a particular value.
- Find different combinations of coins that equal the same amounts of money.
- Solve simple problems involving addition and subtraction of money of the same unit, including giving change.
- Multiplication and Division
- Recall and use multiplication and division facts for the 2, 5 and 10 times tables.
- Use the multiplication (\times), division (\div) and equals ($=$) sign.
- Solve problems involving multiplication and division, using materials, arrays, repeated addition, mental methods and multiplication and division facts, including problems in contexts.
- Show that the multiplication of two numbers can be done in any order (commutative) and division of one number by another cannot.

Computing

- In online safety we will cover digital footprints.
- Children will continue to familiarise themselves with Google Classroom, touch typing and their digital literacy skills including online research.

History

- Great Fire of London 1666- cause,

Science

Materials Monster - Material properties and how they can be changed.

- Children will be comparing the suitability of a variety of everyday materials.
- We will find out how the shapes of solid objects made from some materials can be changed by squashing, bending, twisting and stretching.

Art, Design & Technology

- We will explore landscape paintings by the artist John Ndambo. Children create their own landscapes.
- We will also be looking at the artist John Constable and children create a painting using this style.
- Children will design, make and evaluate: A Tudor house linked to their Great Fire of London learning.

Music

- Children will continue to learn and master their ensemble performance of Imagine and layer different percussion instruments into the composition.
